

## Layering Paint™ (Pallet Flag)

Products: Faux Effects® Layering Paint™, Faux Effects® Star Stencil,

Stain & Seal<sup>™</sup> Van Dyke Brown, Faux Effects<sup>®</sup> Poly Wood Wax<sup>™</sup>,

Tools: Foam Brush, Tape, Sanding Blocks, Soft Cheesecloth, Stencil Adhesive

Step 1. Clean up and tighten gaps in an old pallet.

Step 2. Apply a layer of Faux Effects® Layering Paint™ Tint Base to seal the wood.

Allow to dry 2-3 hours

Step 3. Tape off and paint your flag pattern with Faux Effects® Layering Paint™. Faux Effects® Layering Paint™ Tint Base (White), Berry (Red) and Sapphire (Blue).

Allow to dry 2-3 hours

Step 4. Paint stars using the Faux Effects® Star Stencil and Tint Base (White). This step may take several coats to make opaque.

Allow to dry 2-3 hours

Step 5. Sand entire surface creating an aged look.

Step 6. For additional aging, using cheesecloth wipe on a coat of thinned Stain & Seal™ (Van Dyke Brown).

Allow to dry 2-3 hours

Tips:

Step 7. Apply using cheesecloth a coat of Faux Effects® Poly Wood Wax™ to seal and protect.

• Always complete a sample to ensure the predicted result.

• Mix thoroughly before each use.

Additional Layering Paint<sup>™</sup> may be applied to achieve desired look.

Do not overwork Poly Wood Wax<sup>™</sup> as it dries quickly.
